What does a healthy, God-honoring relationship between a pastor and congregation look like? The foundation of a contagiously joyful and effective congregational ministry is rooted in a good and grace-filled relationship between parish members and pastoral leaders, but how does that happen?

In this seminar, Concordia Seminary's Dr. Bruce Hartung will lead participants through presentation, discussion and group activities to discover where and how pastors and their "flocks" can grow in relationship to build a stronger, holistic and more mission-driven community of faith!

Seminar topics will include an exploration of:

- Typical core issues in a "not-so-together" relationship
- Building blocks of human interaction in the body of Christ
